


Messy Matters Easter

Easter - The empty tomb

Bible verse Luke 24:1-3

Very early on Sunday morning the women went to the tomb, carrying the spices they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the entrance to the tomb, so they went in; but they did not find the body of Lord Jesus.

The empty tomb is one of the great symbols of Easter. Jesus' body had been placed in the tomb, but when the women went to

Something to Do

Take a small piece of bread dough- enough to make a bread roll.

Wrap the bread dough around a marshmallow, making sure that the marshmallow is completely surrounded.

Bake the roll in the oven at the same temperature and time as you would a normal bread roll (around 220°C/425°F/Gas 7.for 8-10 minutes.)

When it looks golden brown, take the roll out of the oven and check whether it is cooked through. You can do this by tapping on the bottom of the roll. If it sounds hollow, it should be cooked.

Now break open the roll. What can you see? The marshmallow should have dissolved during the baking, leaving you with a roll that is hollow insidelike the empty tomb.

Prayer

Lord God we thank you for the events of the first Easter when Jesus died that we might know your love and forgiveness and then rose again that we might have life. May the Easter message speak to me and may I experience the life of Jesus day by day.




