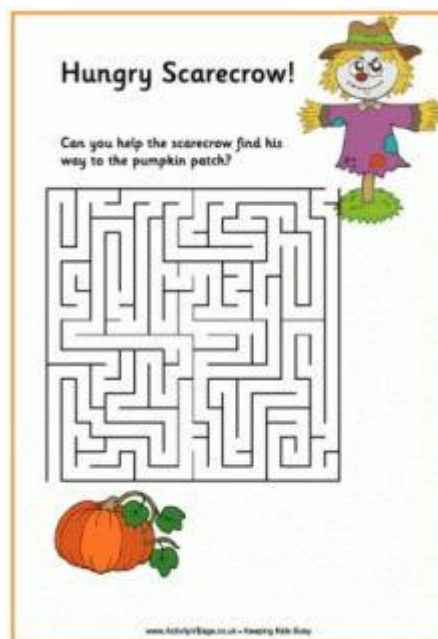


Each month we encourage you to bring friends or relatives , we really do want to invite ALL ages to our sessions and to welcome as many of the community we can to join Our Church Family.

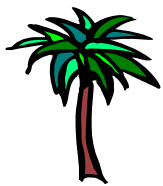
Messy Church will be adding to the decoration so we

## Our Project Oasis

You may have already heard of this but it will be happening very  
shortly at the rear entrance to the church and might affect you when you arrive  
for next month's Messy Church.

The aim of Project Oasis is to refurbish the rear entrance to our premises. The  
old toilet building will be demolished to make a more welcoming entrance. The ex-  
isting gates will be moved back towards the car park and the surface levelled to  
enable gentle slopes up to the Main Hall, Follett Hall and Living Room entrances.  
Part of the steps outside the Little Chapel will be removed and a wheelchair lift  
installed to the right of the doors.

The new area will have seating, a water feature and landscaping to create a quiet  
contemplative part of our premises. Lighting will be introduced to enable the area  
to be used in the evening when weather permits. It will look really great when it's  
finished, please just be patient while the work takes place.

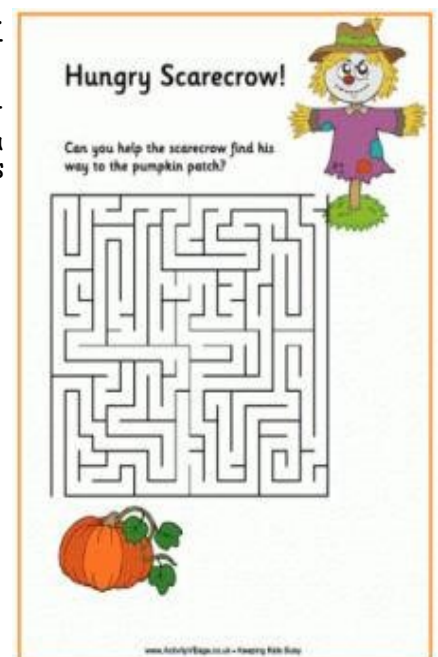

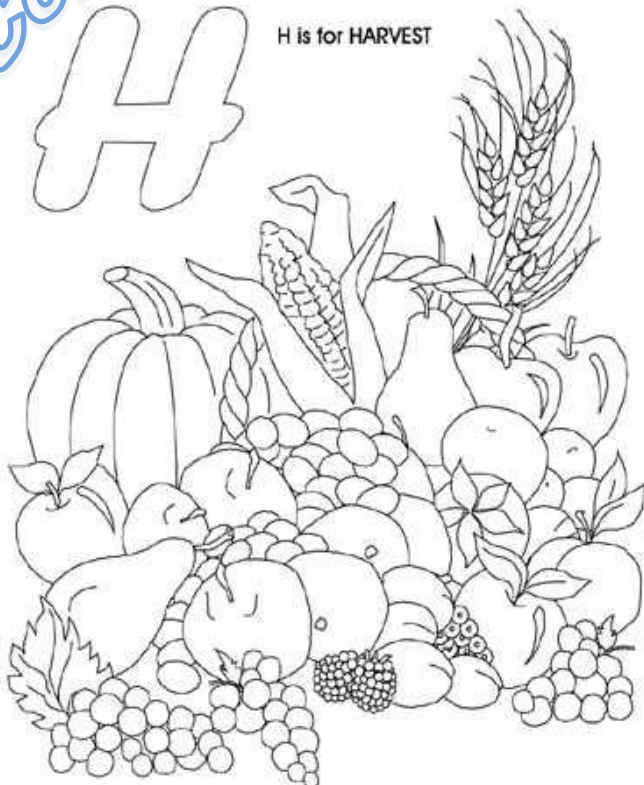
