Loving the Poor

You may not feel very rich but you are. The fact that you live in the UK means that your family is among the richest in the world. Did you know that:

- 80% of the world live on less that £1.50 a day
- 750 billion people don't have safe water to drink
- 22,000 children die a day due to poverty
- life expectancy in the UK is 81 years but only 56 years in Uganda the richest 1% of the world nearly own as much as the rest of the world put together

There are many very poor people who live in the developing areas of the world such as Africa, India and Asia. Today charities and individuals devote their time and resources to helping those less fortunate than ourselves. However, one of the first to do this type of work was Amy Carmichael who over a 100 years ago travelled to India as a Christian Missionary. Despite poor health she served in India for 55 years working to help the orphans and poor of the country. By the end of her life she had cared for over 1000 children. Amy was a true example to us all by loving both God and other people.

Dear Lord thank you for Amy Carmichael. Thank you that you used her to help hundreds of children, and to tell them how much you loved them. Help us to see who you want us to love, and how you want us to give. Help us to tell people about you.
