Chris's Messy Thoughts

Reading: Luke 12: 13-21

This month at Messy church we are thinking about a story Jesus told. In it a rich man

successfully grows lots of crops on his land. He fills up all the barns he has and decides to build

more, thinking that if he stores up enough, he will be able sit back, take things easy, and enjoy life. Sadly, the man in Jesus' story dies before he has a chance to

enjoy his 'riches'. It is a story, but it is a story intended to make us think. We live in a world where people like a lot about 'stuff' - nice things, money in the bank, bigger houses, and investments for secure futures. Not many of us have barns, but we store up possessions in lots of other places!

The man in Jesus' story might have worked hard, but he missed the point that, just like everything we have, all his possessions were actually things God had created, blessed him with, and given him the opportunity to use wisely or foolishly. He is often called the Rich Fool because he didn't understand that the **most** precious thing he could have was a close relationship with God, and that is something that lasts forever. It is also something that can help us appreciate and use wisely everything else that God gives us. Can you think of a different, happier ending to the story Jesus told?


