Chris's Messy Thoughts

John 11: 1-46 Lazarus

We hear about a lot of Jesus' friends in the Bible, and this month at Messy church we are thinking about one family he was very close to, a guy called Lazarus, and his sisters Mary and Martha. There are several stories about Jesus visiting their house and sharing meals with them, but the story we are looking at tells us how Mary and Martha desperately asked for Jesus' help when Lazarus became very ill. Jesus was in another place at the time, and strangely, he did not hurry to go and help but waited two days. By the time he reached Bethany, the village they lived in, Lazarus had sadly died. It made Jesus sad to see his friends upset, but he was not worried. He went to Lazarus' tomb and brought him back to life. He walked out of the tomb in spite of having been dead for several days!

Jesus turned the sadness of Lazarus' death, into a chance to show his power to rescue his friends from death! How cool is that, having a friend more powerful than death! And better still, Jesus wants us to be his friends too! So, with a friend like that, there's not too much to be scared of!
