Ted's Messy Thoughts



"Temptation"

Every day we are tempted. Tempted to have that extra chocolate biscuit; to eat that so good to look at burger; to have our favourite fizzy drink. But sometimes we are tempted in a more serious way. We might be tempted to behave in a way we know is wrong. To say words that hurtful or do something that will get us into trouble if we are found out.

Jesus was tempted too. He went into the desert to be alone and while he was there the devil tempted him to show off his power. When Jesus was hungry the devil tempted him to turn stones into bread; when Jesus was tired the devil tempted him to get the angels to save him; and when Jesus was thirsty the devil tempted him with the offer of power and wealth. Each and every time that Jesus was tempted he turned to God.

Each month we encourage you to bring friends or relatives, we really do want to invite ALL ages to our sessions and to welcome as many of the community we can to join Our Church Family.




On registering please make sure Ted has up to date details for you as this helps communication, to let you know of events coming up or if the weather is bad, what we plan to do at MESSY.


