Do you enjoy making things? A great aspect of Messy Church is all the creativity that goes on, so I expect you do. I certainly do. Some of my work has involves making things in wood and I get great satisfaction from pausing at the end of a day to look back over what I have made. Interestingly, the Bible tells us God did just that as he created the world. A number of times he pauses to observe his creation taking shape, and tells himself 'It was good'. Our new Minister David Bedford & his wife Lorna will be here for their first Sunday, we welcome him to West Street and also would invite you to come and meet with him.


His Induction Service is at 2pm on Saturday 15th October (All Welcome)


